From 1994 – 2022 Mr. Rydder was Chairman of the Board, and since 2006, Mr. Rydder has been fulltime CEO as well and is currently responsible for the overall management Oak Creek Holdings, Inc. (and Oak Creek Energy Systems, Inc.), which is owned by over 410 shareholders, including Commercial Bank of California.

Mr. Rydder was responsible for the overall management of an international development company owned by NEG Micon/Vestas of Denmark. GREP was a continuation of M & N, which in 2002 was purchased 100% by NEG Micon. Vestas then merged with NEG Micon in 2004. GREP was the co-owner and operator of one of the largest wind projects in the world at the time (400 MW in Altamont, California). GREP Canada closed financing on the largest project at the time in Canada in 2004 (104 MW).

Mr. Rydder was responsible for the overall management of an international development company, which has developed a number of wind projects in Europe, Canada, and the United States. M & N Wind Power was a Dutch Joint

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Venture between NEG Micon and Nichimen Corporation, with subsidiaries in England, Ireland, Canada, and the United States. The company was also the co-owner and operator of two of the largest wind projects in the world at the time, both are in North America.

Mr. Rydder was responsible for the operation of the NEG Micon UK, U.S. and Canadian subsidiaries and the management of the M & N Wind Power Group and all other development activities within the NEG Micon Group.

As the senior officer of this wholly owned U.S. subsidiary of the Danish wind turbine manufacturer; Micon A/S, Mr. Rydder was responsible for the structure and development of wind energy projects with the SeaWest Group and other major California developers. Such activities resulted in the sale of over 1,700 wind turbine generators. During this period, total sales exceeded \$125 million, which included the management and service of said equipment. Further, his responsibilities included a wind-down of the Micon organization in California, including a sale of the Micon service and maintenance organization to the SeaWest Group in San Diego.

Mr. Rydder was responsible for the financial planning of all SeaWest related entities and prospective ventures. His responsibilities included project administration of over 2,700 wind turbine generators being managed or owned by SeaWest. He was also responsible for Corporate Accounting and Domestic Development of wind energy projects. As a member of the Board of Directors and as the Chief Financial Officer of all SeaWest companies, he participated in the general management of the SeaWest Group. In 1994/95, he was stationed in London, where he was Managing Director of SeaWest (UK) Ltd. and SeaWest Espana S.A., which companies were constructing five of the largest wind energy projects in the U.K., as well as the first private CHP project (Co-Gen Project) in Spain. SeaWest was later sold to AES Corporation (www.aes.com).
